

Logging into the wireless network from the public area

A login and password are required to access the NYAM Library wireless:

Wireless Access Hardware Minimum Requirement

CPU: Pentium 4

Operating System: Windows XP, Window Vista, Mac OS X

Memory: minimum of 256 MB

Wireless Card. 802.11a, b, g.

(If you do not know specs in detail, a rule of thumb is that the equipment should be less than 3 years old.)
